

## **Rochester Area Teacher Recruitment Day Success Rate Details:**

The following information is presented to assist you in clarifying your expectations for the Rochester Area TRD and TRD USA events, and as a tool to help you decide in which of the events you choose to participate. Please keep in mind that you may participate in both events if you wish.

### **Quick Facts:**

336 Candidates registered for Rochester Area Teacher Recruitment Day last year.

131 Candidates attended the TRD USA portion of the program

35 Districts/70 Recruiters attended the Rochester Area Teacher Recruitment Day program

70 Districts/154 Recruiters attended the TRD USA portion of the program

72% of candidates who registered for Teacher Recruitment Day last year received at least one interview

65% of candidates submitting resumes for the Rochester Area TRD program were granted at least one

82% of candidates who attended TRD USA generated at least one interview

The number of interviews each candidate received varied greatly depending on the demand for their certification area and their willingness to relocate.

The number of interviews granted to candidates in the Rochester Area TRD ranged from 12 to 0 with an average of just over 2 interviews per candidate.

The number of interviews granted to candidates who attended TRD USA ranged from 14 to 0 with an average of just over 4 interviews per candidate.
